Presentation by April Shaw	April Shaw from Services for Independent Living provided an overview of the Young Adult Council, a new program of SIL funded by the Ohio Developmental Disabilities Council.		
	- This will give young adults with disabilities the platform to expand their systems change advocacy efforts.		
	 Issue areas of focus are the direct care crisis, medical discrimination, and education. 		
	- This is the second year of the five year grant funded project.		
Director's Report	Jeremy Morris, SILC Director, provided a report.		
	- Last fiscal year is still in closing process, so final year end report will be given later.		
	- In the new fiscal year, the SILC will be modernizing its fiscal records storage and approval system. This includes adding an online platform for expense approval to simplify the process for regular expense approval and approvals that needs Treasurer approval.		
	- The office of the SILC is fully functional and Committees can begin meeting there in the future.		
	 Internal goal of the SILC this year is to review and update internal processes and procedures. 		
	 Youth Leadership Program contract is under negotiation, Athens will be added as a regional site. 		
	- SILC Recruitment will need to pick up a lot next year. We will be losing several members due to term limits.
